1	<p>Site Inspection</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The landfill operational area was inspected by the group. The group also visited the Tiromoana Bush observation area near Barbara's Gate, and viewed the water supply dam and wetland.
2	<p>Action Items</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Martin apologised for the late delivery of the minutes• The Trigger Levels reports have been sent to William• A bound copy of the consent conditions has been sent to all members• A list of trucks approved for access to the landfill has been sent to all members.• Judith has been sending the monitoring reports to Alec.• Minutes of the CLG meeting have been sent to Te Runanga o Ngai Tahu
3	<p>Correspondence</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Alec advised that he had received a letter from Mayor Jackson of Hurunui District Council in response to a letter from William regarding the possibility of the Kate Valley Landfill receiving waste from outside Canterbury.
4	<p>Reports</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Complaints register. The complaints received were discussed. It was agreed that the complaints to date have been minor.• Hurunui DC Monitoring Reports. Alec advised that he was receiving these from Judith. There were no particular matters raised.• The Peer Review Annual Report was distributed to the CLG for information.• Martin advised that the Landfill Annual Report had been sent to Hurunui DC and Environment Canterbury. A copy of this is available to members of the CLG.
5	<p>Landfill Construction Programme</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Martin outlined the proposed programme of construction of future stages of the landfill.

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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • He advised that lining of Phase 1A-2 may be required prior to the winter of 2006.
6	<p>General Business</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • William asked about the presence of heavy metals in the leachate and whether these are tested for. Richard advised he would report on this at the next meeting. William also asked for a list of the SVOC / VOC items that are tested for. • A number of the members of the CLG expressed their concern about the manner in which the selection of the Community Trust was undertaken. They felt that it was not as transparent as it could have been as compared to the selection of the CLG. Martin is to advise Transwaste of this concern. • Concern was expressed about number the CWS trucks parking outside the Amberley Diner, particularly on Saturday mornings. • Robin asked about the placing of the deceleration signs and road markings.
