At the pre-hearing conference on 8 June a number of parties indicated that they would like to present evidence by way of Audio Visual Link (AVL). In accordance with Judge Harland minute of 18 June I have made inquiries in relation to this request.

I can confirm we will be sitting at the Christchurch Environment Court (Cambridge Tce) and Southbrook Community Sports Club in Rangiora - You will be advised of the dates for these sittings shortly.

Neither venue has AVL technology.

Her honour has indicated in her minute of 18 June that any party that wishes to present a witness via AVL will need to make an application to the Court.

The Court has not received any applications, however the parties need to be aware that if they intend to do so, they will be responsible for organising the technology.

Previous hearings have used Skype, and have hired the equipment at their own expense.
