DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Daryl Tennyson Neate for renewal of a Manager's Certificate.

Daryl has been involved in the hospitality industry for approximately 50 years. In recent years, he has been a relief duty manager at various licensed premises. His main role now is as the bar manager and duty manager at the Woodend Bowling Club. The bar is staffed on a roster system where the duty managers are rostered on for a week at a time.

Daryl was first issued his manager's certificate in Hurunui in 2004. He has lodged his renewal applications in the Hurunui District since that time. His current application has been processed in Hurunui where it was lodged, however future renewals are to be made in the district where Daryl primarily works as a duty manager.

In their reports, the Police and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to renewal.

Under section 218 of the Act the Committee must not renew a manager's certificate unless the manager holds the prescribed qualification.

As the applicant has successfully completed the Licence Controller Qualification Bridging Test, the committee is satisfied that the criteria as set out in s.224 of the Act has been met.

A renewal notice can be issued and will remain in force until 10 April 2022.
