DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Waiau River Estate Limited for renewal of an Off-Licence in respect of premises situated at 2254 Mouse Point Road, Culverden, known as "Hells Gate Wines".

No changes to the conditions of the licence have been sought by the applicant.

Waiau River Estate Limited has traded as Hells Gate Wines since 15 February 2018. This is a family business and has previously traded as Marble Point Winery.

The winery has three certificate holding duty managers thereby providing adequate cover during the licensed trading hours.

A check of the website found it to be non-compliant as the required licence information and a copy of the licence was not displayed on the site. There is also no second age declaration prior to the customer entering the payment system.

The applicants provided information to the winery website provider. Changes were made, however, the provider put the licence information in the incorrect location i.e. it was not prominent as it was accessed via a link. This was rectified.

The second age declaration will now be added when the renewed licence details are updated.

The off-licence information is to be updated on the website within two working days following the renewed licence information being emailed to the licensee.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act. We renew the licence on the existing terms and conditions until 15 February 2022, that being three years from the first anniversary of the licence.

Due to a practice direction from the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority we authorise the issue of a replacement licence with a new number and notice of renewal.
