DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Hanmer Hospitality Limited for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 824 Hanmer Springs Road, Hanmer Springs and known as Lochiel Station

The nature of the particular series of events for which the licence is sought is the South Island Dog Trial Championship with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Sunday 05 – Saturday 11 May 2019 from 11.00am to 7.00pm. The bar will cease trading at 6.30pm each day to allow a 'drink up' time.

The licensed area is undesignated and includes a PGG Wrightson marquee, a Farmlands Marquee and the fenced off area surrounding them.

The special licence is for the South Island Dog Trial Championship to be held on a rural property, Lochiel Station, in the Hanmer Springs area. The dog trials will be held over seven days in early May 2019.

The applicant expects approximately 200 people to attend the event each day. The people attending will be of a wide age range.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event.

The licence may issue immediately.
