Covid 19 – Traffic Light System – Orange

Orange

Public and Private gatherings (ie weddings, faith based, parties, clubs, social sports free concerts, community fairs and funerals) can go ahead. No limit on the number of people who can attend.

You can serve food and drink at your gathering.

Face covering:

- You do not need to wear a face mask at a gathering, but it is encouraged.
- Workers and volunteers at gatherings must wear face masks — unless they are exempt.
- Performers and formal speakers do not need to wear a face mask when performing or speaking. They should wear face masks when not performing or speaking.

Controlled-access events (involve ticketing, registration, or another way to control access) – There are no limits to how many people can attend an event or public facility.

When food and drink is being served, you must be seated and separated.

Face covering:

- If you are attending a gathering or event, you do not need to wear a face mask either indoors or outdoors.

- You do not need to wear a face mask at an event, either indoors or outdoors.
- Workers and volunteers at indoor events must wear face masks — unless they are exempt.

Indoor Sport - Indoor and outdoor sport events can go ahead at Orange. This includes community and professional sport.

There are no capacity limits indoors

Council Organized or Operated Events – Go ahead in accordance with Government restrictions.
