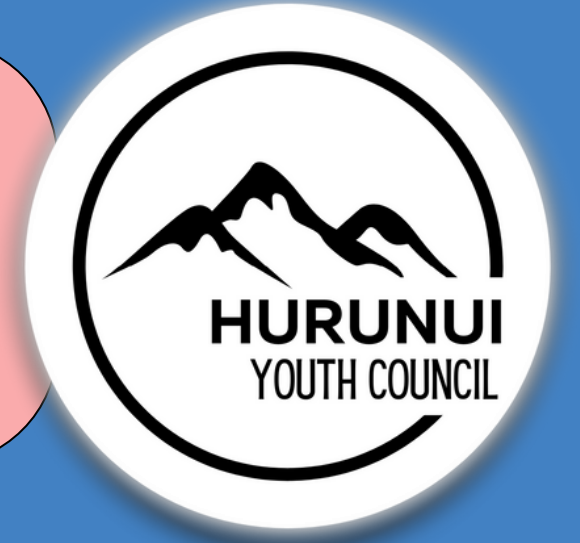


# Hurunui Youth Take Over Survey 2023

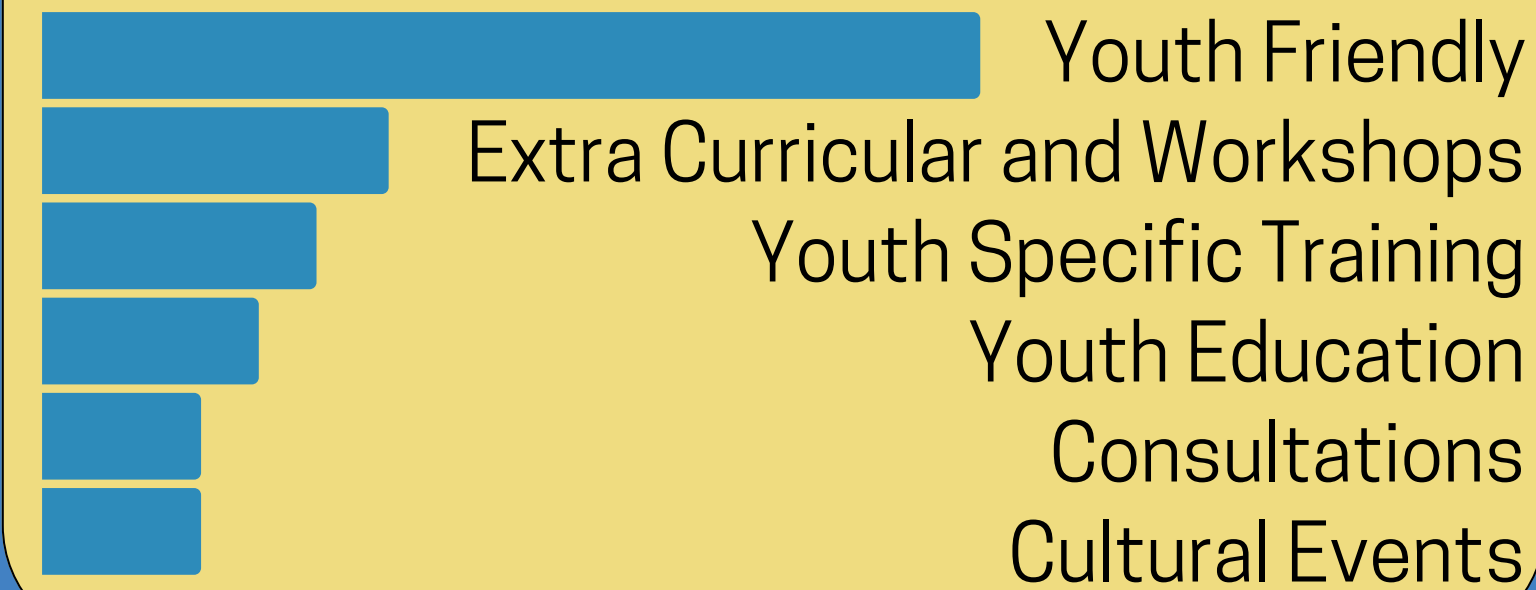
Surveys were gathered online@hurunuiyouth and in person at:

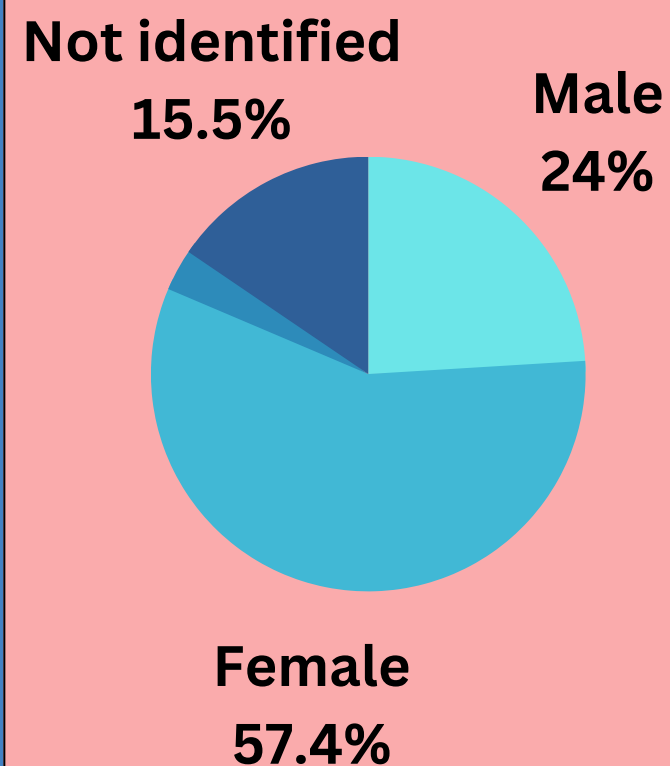

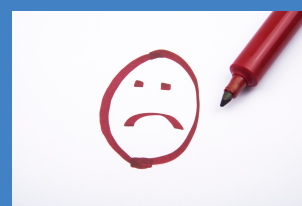
