DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Amberley Golf Club Incorporated for renewal of an Club Licence in respect of premises situated at Amberley Beach, known as "Amberley Golf Club Incorporated".

The application listed Larry Brown as the only duty manager for the club. Larry has since had a change of circumstances and indicated he will no longer be the club duty manager.

Two club members have been granted manager's certificates and will share the duty manager's role. They have experience selling and supplying alcohol at the golf club bar.

The current renewal application contained an earlier version of the licensed area plan. This has been discussed with the applicant and copies of the plans for the currently licensed areas were provided. It has been suggested that a copy of the plans be held in the bar area for staff to reference. Also all duty managers and bar staff are to be made aware of the areas that are licensed to ensure compliance with the licence conditions.

The licensed areas are 'undesigned' and include:

Ground Floor:

- Club house room

First Floor:

- Main club house room

Outdoor areas:

- Concrete paved veranda in front of the club house
- Outdoor barbecue area

No changes to the conditions of the licence have been sought by the applicant.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act. We renew the licence *on the existing terms and conditions* until 22 August 2019, that being *the anniversary date of the licence and three years from the most recent date of expiry*.

Due to a practice direction from the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority we authorise the issue of a replacement licence with a new number and notice of renewal.
