DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Stephanie Jean Henderson-Grant & Andrew John Grant for renewal of an Off-Licence in respect of premises situated at 83 Church Road, Glenmark, known as "Ataahua Wines".

No changes to the conditions of the licence have been sought by the applicant.

Stephanie Jean Henderson-Grant & Andrew John Grant have traded as Ataahua Wines since 2009. Sales of wine are made via the internet or through telephone orders based from the office in the applicant's house.

Stephanie Henderson-Grant is the sole duty manager for Ataahua Wines. She has held a manager's certificate since October 2009.

Stephanie has been reminded at various special licensed events to ensure that the correct signage, including a copy of the special licence, is displayed at the stall. It is suggested that these resources be assembled into a kit and taken to each event.

An audit of the website was conducted on 3 May 2019 and Stephanie was advised by email of non-compliances that required addressing.

The website displayed an incorrect licence number, as it referred to Stephanie's manager's certificate not the off-licence. There was no link to a copy of the off-licence.

The correct licence details (number and expiry date) have been changed on the website. A link to a copy of the licence has also been added to ensure compliance with the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act and Regulations.

The renewed licence details are required to be updated on the website within two working days of receipt.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act. We renew the licence *on the existing terms and conditions* until __, that being *three years from the first anniversary of the licence / the anniversary date of the licence and three years from the most recent date of expiry*.

Due to a practice direction from the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority we authorise the issue of a replacement licence with a new number and notice of renewal.
