DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Cribb Farming Limited for renewal of an Off-Licence in respect of premises situated at 169 MacKenzies Road, Waipara, known as "Waipara River Estates".

There has been a change in the directors and shareholders of Cribb Farming Limited. Bernice Cribb ceased to be a company director on 29 March 2019 and a shareholder on 4 April 2019. These changes were notified to the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority (ARLA) by email on 24 May 2019.

The off-licence hours are:

Monday to Sunday 8.00am to 10.00pm

No changes to the conditions of the licence have been sought by the applicant.

Cribb Farming Limited trades as Waipara River Estates and has held an off-licence for one year. The Inspector is not aware of non-compliance issues associated with the operation of the premises.

The licensed areas are all undesignated and include the sitting room, lounge, dining area, entrance foyer and the paved outdoor area between the sitting room and the fenced swimming pool area.

The website should be updated with the new licence details within 2 working days of being received. Any problems with this should be discussed with the Secretary.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act. We renew the licence on the existing terms and conditions until 16 August 2022, that being three years from the first anniversary of the licence.

Due to a practice direction from the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority we authorise the issue of a replacement licence with a new number and notice of renewal.
