DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by GJ & DS Pearson for renewal of an Off-Licence Endorsed under S.40 for Remote Sales only in respect of premises situated at 255 MacKenzies Road, Waipara, known as "Mon Cheval Wines".

No changes to the conditions of the licence have been sought by the applicant.

GJ & DS Pearson trade as Mon Cheval Wines under an off-licence endorsed for remotes sales of alcohol. Graham and Deborah Pearson are the partners for this business, and they have operated the winery since 2003. The off-licence has been held for one year.

A check of the website found it to be compliant.

The website should be updated with the new licence details within 2 working days of the documents being received.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act. We renew the licence on the existing terms and conditions until 07 June 2022, that being three years from the first anniversary of the licence.

Due to a practice direction from the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority we authorise the issue of a replacement licence with a new number and notice of renewal.
