DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by No 31 Hanmer Limited for renewal of an On-Licence in respect of premises situated at 31 Amuri Avenue, Hanmer Springs, known as "No 31 Restaurant & Bar".

No changes to the conditions of the licence have been sought by the applicant.

No 31 Hanmer Limited, trades as No 31 Restaurant & Bar, and has held an on-licence since September 2015. Kim and Steven Gill are the company directors and shareholders. They have operated licensed restaurants for 18 years.

The licensed hours are: Monday to Sunday from 8.00am to 12.00 midnight.

The licensed areas are undesignated and include: The interior of the restaurant and the outdoor courtyard at the front of the premises.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act. We renew the licence on the existing terms and conditions until 22 September 2022, that being the anniversary date of the licence and three years from the most recent date of expiry.

Due to a practice direction from the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority we authorise the issue of a replacement licence with a new number and notice of renewal.
