DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Amuri Collie Club for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 824 Hanmer Springs Road, Hanmer Springs and known as Lochiel Station

The nature of the particular event for which the licence is sought is the Amuri Collie Club Dog Trials with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being **Thursday 04 April 2019 from 10.00am to 9.00pm and Friday 05 April 2019 from 10.00am to 9.30pm**. The bar will cease serving alcohol 30 minutes prior to the end of the event to allow a 'drink up' time. The licensed areas are undesignated and include the cookhouse, the bar buildings and the adjacent roped off outdoors area.

Robert Roborgh is the proposed manager for the event and although he does not hold a manager's certificate the Committee is satisfied that he will manage the conduct of the sale of alcohol in accordance with the licence. The licensee is exempt from the requirements of appointing a manager under subpart 7 of the Act.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event.

The licence may issue immediately.
