DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Amberley Returned and Services Association Club for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 50 Douglas Road, Amberley and known as Amberley Domain Hall

The nature of the particular event (or series of occasions or events) for which the licence is sought is the Anzac Day After Service Social Gathering with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Thursday 25 April 2019 from 12.00 midday to 3.30pm. The licensed area is undesignated and includes the interior of the Amberley domain hall (Tin Shed)

The Amberley Returned and Services Association Club (RSA) held a special licence for the gathering after the 2017 and 2018 ANZAC Day services. The club has arranged for an experienced duty manager to manage the bar. Members of the Lions Club and RSA will support her as bar and security staff and they will be fully briefed on their roles and responsibilities.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event.

The licence may issue immediately.
