DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Amberley Primary School for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 50 Douglas Road, Amberley and known as Amberley Pavillion - Tin Shed

The nature of the particular event for which the licence is sought is Quiz Night - School Fundraiser with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Saturday 18 May 2019 from 6.30pm to 11.00pm. The bar will cease serving alcohol 30 minutes prior to the end of the event to allow a 'drink up' time'.

The licensed area is supervised and includes the interior of the Amberley pavilion hall.

Amberley Primary School has not held previous special licensed events. The quiz night is not considered to be a high risk alcohol event and the applicant has engaged an experienced duty manager to oversee the sale and supply of alcohol.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event.

The licence may issue immediately.
