DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Waiau Pool Committee for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 32 Parnassus Street, Waiau and known as Waiau Rugby Club

The nature of the particular event (or series of occasions or events) for which the licence is sought is The Waiau Annual Pig Hunt with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Sunday 27 October 2019 from 1.00pm to 8.00pm. The bar will cease serving alcohol at 7.30pm to allow a 'drink up' time.

The licensed area is undesignated and includes the interior of the clubrooms and a roped off area in front of the club and part of the rugby field.

The event is to raise funds for the maintenance and upkeep of the new Waiau community swimming pool.

Hamish Galletly is the proposed manager for this event and has been the bar manager at previous special licensed events. He holds a current manager's certificate and is a duty manager at the Hurunui Rugby Club in Culverden.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event.

The licence may issue immediately.
