DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Friends of Glenmark Church Incorporated for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 11 Reeces Road, Omihi and known as Omihi Community and Sports Hall

The nature of the particular event for which the licence is sought is the Friends of Glenmark Church Fundraising Dinner with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Saturday 12 October 2019 from 6.00pm to 12.00 Midnight. The licensed area is supervised and includes the Omihi main hall and supper room and the exterior north and west paved and grassed areas.

Friends of Glenmark Church Incorporated named Daryl Harris as the duty manager for the event. Daryl has held a manager's certificate since January 2011. He is the licensee and duty manager for the remote sale of alcohol for Harris Estate Wines.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event.

The licence may issue immediately.
