DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Ruahine Ports Limited for an off-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 1 Jacks Pass Road, Hanmer Springs and known as Queen Mary Hospital Grounds

The nature of the particular event for which the licence is sought is a stall at Hanmer Springs Fete with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being **Friday 01 November 2019 from 10.00am to 4.00pm.**

The licensed area is undesignated and includes the 1 metre wide area at the front of the stall.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act, and we grant the applicant an off- site special licence authorising the sale of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The licence may issue immediately.
