

# Notice of Decision

**DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)**

This is an application by Sub180 Entertainment Limited for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 376 Ram Paddock Road, Broomfield and known as The Boneline Winery.

The nature of the event for which the licence is sought is Rolling Meadows Festival with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Friday 30 December 2022 from 12.00pm midday to 2.00am the following day, and Saturday 31 October 2022 from 12.00pm midday to 2.00am the following day.

The licensed area is restricted and includes the third paddock off the road, in the fenced off area.

The Police and Medical Officer of Health initially submitted reports in opposition to the application. The main concerns were around the systems and management of the event including, but not limited to, the availability of food and non-alcoholic beverages, the licensed hours and alcohol availability, and health and safety/emergency services.

The Tri-Agencies (Licensing Inspector, Police and Medical Officer of Health Representative) met with the applicant on-site to discuss the systems and management of the event. Following the meeting, the applicant submitted an amended Alcohol Management Plan

The Police and Medical Officer of Health subsequently withdrew their opposition.

In her report, the Licensing Inspector did not oppose the application. The Licensing Inspector, however, recommended that the licensing committee considers imposing the following condition under s. 117 of the Act:

- *Serve limit of 2 alcoholic beverages per transaction, dropping down to 1 alcoholic beverage per transaction from 1.00 am (or earlier at the discretion of the duty manager).*

We have considered the recommendation from the Licensing Inspector, and we are of a mind that the condition is reasonable and aims to achieve the object of the Act, set out in s. 4 of the Act.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this event.

The licence may issue immediately, subject to the following condition:

- A serve limit of two (2) alcoholic beverages per transaction applies to this licence. The serve limit must drop down to one (1) alcoholic beverage per transaction from 1.00 am (or earlier at the discretion of the duty manager).
