DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Cheviot Collie Club for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 15 Fagans Road, Leamington Valley (Cheviot) and known as Koromiko Farm.

The nature of the event for which the licence is sought is Cheviot Collie Trials with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Thursday 9 February 2023 from 11.00am to 7.30pm and Friday 10 February 2023 from 11.00am to 7.30pm. The licensed area is supervised and includes:

- The interior of the woolshed, and
- An adjacent roped off outdoor area.

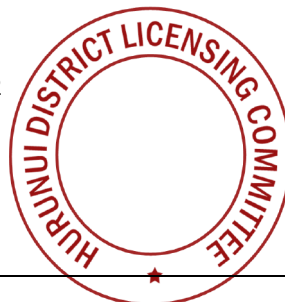
In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

The Licensing Inspector confirmed that the applicant has not proposed to appoint a certified manager as required by s. 213(1) of the Act. The Inspector considers the proposed managers, Annie Ashford and Abby Dillon, to be suitably experienced and responsible, who will manage the conduct of the sale of alcohol in accordance with the licence. We are satisfied that an exemption to the requirement to appoint a certified manager, in accordance with s. 213(2) of the Act, is approved.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this event.

The licence may issue immediately.
