

CoastSnap is now live!

These stands are part of a community monitoring program where people can use their mobile devices to take a photo of the beach state from a fixed point. The observations can be used to track changes in the shoreline and see long term changes in the beach state such as accretion and erosion.

To use the CoastSnap stands simply place your phone sideways in the cradle and take a photo. These can be uploaded directly onto the CoastSnap app, shared via social media with the hashtag #CoastSnapLeithfield or emailed directly to coastal@hurunui.govt.nz

There are two photo points at Leithfield Beach. The north stand is in the carpark at the north end of the settlement off Elizabeth Square. The central stand is accessible from the Leithfield Beach Reserve carpark at 1 Lucas Drive. Follow the access track onto the beach and turn left.
