Submission Freedom Camping Hanmer Springs

I believe we should not discourage freedom camping, what we should do is offer an area where they can park, camp overnight in safety and in my opinion be within walking distance of all the facilities we offer..

I am completely against having 2 sites available for freedom camping at the Library and Chisholm Reserve. These areas are not safe as they are to close to all our local bars, restaurants etc and the intoxication that follows. They are also too close to the centre of the village, no where is this common. If you wish to stay in the centre of a town or city then you pay like everyone else.

I have discounted River Reserve as the primary location for freedom campers for two reasons. I doubt most freedom campers would stay there as it is to far from the village and secondly the cost of bringing the reserve up to standard.

The Brooke Dawson toilet requires replacing with one on the flat to the left as you enter the reserve – connected to all the services. The existing toilet could be replaced at River Reserve giving a cost effective second option for freedom campers.

Currently just about all freedom campers stay in the Department of Conservation (DOC) site on Jollies Pass Road.

To me this is an excellent location, it is within walking distance to the village and the walks and it offers safety.

I have a number of ideas that could make this site even more attractive for all freedom campers, and Hanmer Springs residents, they are;

Southern camping area

 Look at the entrance with DOC, would they consider moving their driving entrance west which would give them their own access. They could use their eastern gates as an entrance to their complex. Block off the old entrance and plant out their fences in natives offering their staff and freedom campers' privacy.

- 2. Raise the northern grass area so it is flat, retaining wall at the cycle track allowing more campers to use the area it does contain the toilet drip lines and I am unsure if this would be acceptable.
- 3. Reduce the number of exotic trees with the planting of natives to make the area more usable.
- 4. Tidy up the main entrance and at the same time make a single access road east / west with more grass areas to park on.
- 5. Introduce passive lighting for safety.

Northern Camping area

Once the southern stage is complete, if freedom camping numbers dictate reopen the old camping area.

- 1. Move the Pawsons Road gate about 20m north.
- 2. Re open the road from Pawsons Road to the old camping area.
- 3. Remove most or all of the redwoods to another site.
- 4. Place a similar toilet block and system in this area.
- 5. Install passive lighting on the access road and camping area.

In addition to the above I would charge users to use the facilities in conjunction to an honesty box for staying. Revenue gained could be put towards maintenance, native conservation of the area.

I would also suggest identifying and keeping areas at both sites available in the event pay showers are required.

If external funding was found the site could be taken over and maintained by the Hurunui District Council utilising as stated above fees from the toilet block/s, donations etc.

Subject: Freedom Campers

Hi folk, I'm unsure whether we have missed the boat again with regard to Freedom Camping. I thought we were going to discuss it again and put our thoughts forward. My personal thoughts go like this:

I am a seasoned traveller, notoriously on the cheap, either in a Camper van or on my trusty bicycle. Nowhere in the world, and as you know I've been around, would I expect to Freedom Camp in the middle of a village or city, unless I was invited on to private property.

I believe here in Hanmer Springs we should not be offering the Freedom Camping in the middle of the village. We are already offering the DOC site, which I believe should be charged for (\$8 per night, as in most other DOC sites), and the area on the west side of the Hanmer river bridge. As a visitor I would be happy to use either site, and would be very thankful. Middle of the Village.....no way, unsightly and unnecessary.

If I wanted to stay more centrally, even as a cheapo traveller, I would find a commercial campsite or motel or simialr. It's not like there are no other options.

My two cents worth. I fell we need to discuss again realyy soon and make our (HSCB) thoughts known.

Background

In 2017 we as association submitted our thoughts and recommendation to the Hurunui District Council as part of the Councils consultation process regarding freedom camping.

Our conclusion was:

We are of the view that the Hanmer Springs basin provides adequate options for freedom camping with the addition of the Hanmer River Reserve Park. We do not support the addition of the proposed sites in the central village as we believe:

- a) That from a customer perspective it is not a good option
- b) The combinations of public and private sector options which range from cost free to commercial cater for the market.

The Council subsequently endorsed for freedom camping site in the central village. We now have the benefit of seeing what has happened since that change happened.

Our position hasn't changed, in fact we wish with the benefit of being able to observe "camper behaviour" to amend our position.

Our original position with additions in italics follows

Submission on Freedom Camping

To: Hurunui District Council **Date:** 7 November 2017

The Hanmer Springs Business Association (HSBA) recognises the role that the campervan sector plays in the overall tourism industry. The HSBA supports responsible tourism and expects visitors to Hanmer Springs to act with appropriate manners.

KEY POINTS

HSBA is of the view that there is no need to have freedom camping sites in the Hanmer Springs township itself. This thought is based on two perspectives – the customers perspective and the availability of other options.

Customer Perspective

The positioning of overnight camping sites in the middle of a built up area is questionable at best. Whilst recognising that Hanmer Springs is not exactly 'Times Square' it does have its periods of time when it is busy in the evening.

Locating campervan sites immediately adjacent to a Hotel is not displaying any consideration for the end customer. Without wanting to cast dispersion on the customers of that hotel they do create noise on exiting the premise and for some the opportunity to interact with a campervan and its inhabitants may be too tempting.

The areas indicated are hardly secluded areas for camping. Similarly the location of a site adjacent to a concrete block wall and a toilet block is not presenting the Village in a positive light. Chisholm Park is a busy place adjacent to three restaurants. Not an ideal place for an overnight camping experience. So we will not be enhancing the customer experience by offering these sites.

The Hanmer Springs Basin has three sites presently and one potential site identified for freedom camping.

- 1. The New Zealand Motorhome Association provide an area for their members adjacent to the Hanmer Springs River Bridge.
- 2. The Hot Springs Hotel provides an area for campervans albeit with a condition. There is a cost to camp but that cost is returned by means of a food and beverage voucher which is redeemable at the Hot Springs Hotel.
- 3. The Department of Conservation provides an area for campervans at its Jollies Pass service area.
- 4. The site that Hurunui District Council has identified at the Hanmer River Reserve will accommodate 10 campervans.

Our view is that Hanmer Springs is/will be well serviced for the 'Freedom Camping Market'. Added to this there are the four camping grounds who offer facilities albeit on a commercial basis.

Observations made since the 4 campervan parks have been put in place

Location; The HSBA does not believe it is wise to put an unmanaged camping site adjacent to a children's playground. Furthermore the locating of camping sites on a main walkway to a primary school is inappropriate. Council should consider their response if an application was made to locate a camping ground next to a school. We would expect that activity would be declined.

The following examples are behaviour that has been witnessed regularly by a resident who lives in close proximity to Chisholm Park. This behaviour has been observed by a number of people.

"It is not unusual to see washing lines of clothing being strung from campervans to structures in the carpark"

"Campers regularly wash, clean teeth etc. in public space"

"Regularly there are 4 campervans in Chisholm Park"

"Families have been observed approaching Chisholm Park only to turn away once they see that campers have spread personal effects – clothes, sleeping bags, tents etc. over the toilet block and the playground itself."

"Rubbish bags are regularly left in the carpark".

These examples individually are offensive. The cumulative effect is unacceptable to both the business and residents alike. As a community we have had the opportunity to observe the behaviour of the campervan community. We are of the view that this is unacceptable conduct that is not in keeping with the values and positioning of Hanmer Springs.

Conclusion

We are of the view that the Hanmer Springs basin provides adequate options for freedom camping with the addition of the Hanmer River Reserve Park. We did not support the establishment of the camp site outside the public library and licensed premise (2parks) or those in the Chisholm Park Reserve adjacent to the children's playground. Given our observations as listed above, the new concerns about the suitability of the location of the campsites and our original statements HSBA recommend there is no freedom camping within the urban areas of Hanmer Springs. These should be disbanded immediately, as there is sufficient camping elsewhere in the Hanmer basin as indicated above.
