Having looked at the proposed freedom camping by-law restrictions it is obvious that that whilst the letter of the freedom camping law is complied with the spirit is not.

Whilst recognising the difficulties that "so-called" freedom campers have caused, the overly severe restrictions on self-contained vehicles means that a considerable number of self contained vehicles are likely to bypass the area completely.

This removes their spending power from your local economy, including the local camping grounds which are regularly used by members of this group to rest and refresh, your local eating and hospitality establishments, repair facilities etc etc. When you consider that this group contains some of the more affluent of the population this would be a pity. I would suggest you investigate the Motorhome friendly towns initiative to see how such visitors can be managed to mutual benefit.
