



## RURAL AND URBAN ADDRESSING POLICY – ADDENDUM

The Council passed the following resolution at their meeting on the 29 October 2015:

THAT THE COUNCIL RESOLVES TO NAME AND NUMBER ALL NEW RIGHTS OF WAY AS FOLLOWS:

- SIX OR MORE LOTS OR POTENTIAL FOR PROPERTIES ON THE RIGHT OF WAY TO BE SUBDIVIDED IN THE FUTURE RESULTING IN SIX OR MORE PROPERTIES. NAME THE RIGHT WAY USING THE ROAD TYPE 'WAY' AND NUMBER AS PER A NORMAL ROAD. THE ROAD SIGN IS TO HAVE 'PRIVATE ROAD' WRITTEN UNDER THE RIGHT OF WAY NAME.
- FIVE OF LESS TO BE NUMBERED OFF THE ROAD THAT THEY ARE ACCESSED OFF USING THE ALPHA SUFFIX NUMBERING SYSTEM.

THAT THE COUNCIL REQUEST THAT A LETTER BE SENT TO PROPERTY OWNERS ON EXISTING RIGHTS OF WAY INFORMING THEM OF THE CHANGE. THE LETTER NEEDS TO EXPLAIN THE CRITERIA THEY WILL NEED TO MEET IF THEY WISH FOR THE RIGHT OF WAY THEY LIVE ON TO BE NAMED AND NUMBERED USING THE NEW SYSTEM. THE CRITERIA IS AS FOLLOWS:

- THE REQUEST TAKES THE FORM OF A PETITION SIGNED BY AT LEAST 80% OF THE OWNERS WHOSE PROPERTIES FRONT THE RIGHT OF WAY.
- THE NAME SUGGESTED BY THE APPLICANT'S MUST BE ACCEPTABLE TO COUNCIL IN TERMS OF THE CRITERIA FOR NAMING ROADS/RIGHTS OF WAY.
- THE APPLICANTS OR PETITIONERS AGREE TO MEET ALL COSTS AND DISBURSEMENTS INCURRED BY COUNCIL (INCLUDING COSTS OF SIGNS, RENUMBERING, ADMINISTRATION ETC).
