



1. TITLE

1.1 This Bylaw is the Hurunui District Council Speed Limits Bylaw 2020.

2. COMMENCEMENT

2.1 This Bylaw comes into force on 2 February 2021.

3. PURPOSE

3.1 The purpose of this Bylaw is to set speed limits on all roads within the jurisdiction of the Hurunui District Council other than State Highways controlled by Waka Kotahi New Zealand Transport Agency.

3.2 This Bylaw is made under the authority of section 22AB of the Land Transport Act 1988 and the Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits 2017.

4. INTERPRETATION

4.1 In this Bylaw, unless the context requires otherwise:

Council means the Hurunui District Council and includes any officer authorised by the Council to act on its behalf.

Road has the same meaning as given in section 2(1) of the Land Transport Act 1998.

Speed Limits Rule means the rule made under the Land Transport Act 1998 for the setting of speed limits that is in force at the time any speed limit is set by this bylaw.

Explanatory note:

The current rule is the Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits 2017.

Speed Limit has the same meaning as given in part 2 of the Speed Limits Rule.

Urban Traffic Area means an area designated by the Council as an Urban Traffic Area in accordance with the Speed Limits Rule.

5. SPEED LIMITS

5.1 The Council may, by resolution, set speed limits on any Road or designate Urban Traffic Areas within the jurisdiction of the Council in any Designated Location in accordance with the requirements of the Speed Limits Rule.

5.2 The Roads described in the attached schedules or as shown in a map referenced in the schedule are declared to have the speed limits specified in the schedule and maps that are part of this bylaw.

5.3 All roads not within a Designated Urban Traffic Area, or otherwise designated as listed in the schedules and shown on the maps, have a speed limit of 100 km/h.

5.4 Subject to compliance with the Speed Limits Rule, the Council may amend or revoke a resolution made under clause 5.1 at any time.

Explanatory notes:

1. Section 2.8 of the Rule requires the Council to establish and maintain a register of speed limits that records all speed limits, except temporary speed limits, and records all designated urban traffic areas for the roads under its jurisdiction. The register of speed limits must be available for inspection by members of the public.

2. In accordance with Section 3.2 of the Speed Limits Rule the Council may set speed limits of 10, 20, 30, 40, 50, 60, 70, 80, 90, 100 or 110 km/h.

6. OFFENCES AND PENALTIES

- 6.1 Every person commits an offence against this Bylaw who operates a vehicle in excess of the speed limits set by this Bylaw.

Explanatory note:

1. *Offences, penalties and fees relating to infringement of speed limits are provided for in the relevant provisions of the Land Transport Act 1998 (and rules or regulations made under that Act). The enforcement of this bylaw is undertaken by the New Zealand Police in accordance with the Land Transport Act 1998, the Land Transport (Road User) Rule 2004 and the Land Transport (Offences and Penalties) Regulations 1999.*

7. REVOCATIONS

- 7.1 On commencement of this bylaw the Hurunui District Council Speed Limits Bylaw 2011 is revoked.
- 7.2 In relation to any matter occurring before this bylaw was made, all speed limits on roads that were in effect before this bylaw was made, continue to have effect for the purposes of:
- a. Investigating an offence or breach:
 - b. Commencing or completing proceedings for the offence or breach:
 - c. Imposing a penalty for the offence or breach.
