Section 137(2) allows the licensing committee to consider an application for a special licence filed less than 20 working days before the event, if they are satisfied that the need for the special licence could not have been foreseen earlier. The applicant has advised that they were not aware that a special licence would be required.

The Committee has agreed to accept this late application on this occasion due to the negative effects to the community if this event was not to take place. The applicant is reminded that any event which is open to the public, rather than just club members, would require a special licence.

The nature of the particular event for which the licence is sought is a Cheviot Community Ball with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Saturday 30 July 2016 from 7.00pm to 12.00 midnight. The licensed area is restricted (no minors are permitted in the licensed area) and includes the interior of the clubrooms and the outside deck and ramp area. The applicant has been advised that alcohol cannot be taken outside this area.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event.
