## **DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)**

This is an application by Barry John O'Regan for renewal of a Manager's Certificate.

He has been a licensee of the Railway Tavern in Amberley since March 2012.

Barry is the primary duty manager at the tavern, and usually ensures he is the duty manager on Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights, particularly if the premises is busy.

In their reports, the Police and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to renewal.

Under section 218 of the Act the Committee must not renew a manager's certificate unless the manager holds the prescribed qualification.

As the applicant has successfully completed the Licence Controller Qualification, the committee is satisfied that the criteria as set out in s.224 of the Act has been met.

A renewal notice can be issued and will remain in force until 20 June 2022.
