## **DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)**

This is an application by Carmela de los Milagros Garvan Orellana for renewal of a Manager's Certificate.

The applicant was born in Lima, Peru and holds a NZ Work Visa for Essential Skills which expires 4 May 2020. The holder may only work as Shift/Assistant Manager in Hanmer Springs for Hanmer Springs Bakery.

Carmela is not currently employed in a licensed premises but is actively seeking employment in the hospitality industry. Once new employment is gained, she will need to alter her work visa to suit.

In their reports, the Police and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to renewal.

The Police commented;

'Police are aware that some DLC's place applications on hold for a specified time until such time the applicant can provide proof that they are working on a licensed premises.

Police feel this would be a suitable measure in this instance as this is a renewal application and the applicant is intending on taking up employment at a licensed premises in the near future

Police do not oppose the application but it is subject to the applicant gaining employment on a licensed premises.'

Under section 218 of the Act the Committee must not renew a manager's certificate unless the manager holds the prescribed qualification.

As the applicant has successfully completed the Licence Controller Qualification under the new Act, the committee is satisfied that the criteria as set out in s.224 of the Act has been met.

A renewal notice can and will be issued, subject to the applicant providing sufficient evidence to the Secretary, that appropriate employment has been gained and her immigration visa has been altered to the new employment position in licensed premises, by or before 23 January 2020.
