DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Deborah Sue Pearson for renewal of a Manager's Certificate.

Deborah and her husband, trading as a partnership GJ and DS Pearson, are the licensees for the off-licence endorsed for remote sale of alcohol for their winery, Mon Cheval Wines. Deborah's role is the sales and account manager, and duty manager for the winery.

Deborah had previously made an undertaking to only use her Managers Certificate whilst acting as duty manager at the Winery or special licensed events.

Although this is still the reason the applicant requires the managers certificate, the District Licensing Committee no longer require an undertaking.


In their reports, the Police and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to renewal.

Under section 218 of the Act the Committee must not renew a manager's certificate unless the manager holds the prescribed qualification.

As the applicant has successfully completed the Licence Controller Qualification under the new Act, the committee is satisfied that the criteria as set out in s.224 of the Act has been met.

A renewal notice can be issued and will remain in force until 07 June 2019.
