## **DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)**

This is an application by Simranjeet Singh for renewal of a Manager's Certificate.

The applicant is an Indian citizen holding a NZ work visa which entitles him to work as any occupation in NZ for any employer. The visa expires 26 September 2020.

Simranjeet worked as a duty manager at Corianders Hanmer Springs at weekends from August to December 2018. He moved to Hanmer Springs in December 2018 and was employed as the restaurant manager and duty manager.

The business has recently been sold and now trades as Coriander Leaf Indian Restaurant. Simranjeet continues to work at the premises as the restaurant manager and duty manager.

In their reports, the Police and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to renewal.

Under section 218 of the Act the Committee must not renew a manager's certificate unless the manager holds the prescribed qualification.

As the applicant has successfully completed the Licence Controller Qualification under the new Act, the committee is satisfied that the criteria as set out in s.224 of the Act has been met.

A renewal notice can be issued and will remain in force until 02 August 2022.
