## **DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)**

This is an application by Leonie Kathleen Hamilton for renewal of a Manager's Certificate.

In their reports, the Police did not oppose the application, however they did state concerns regarding the applicant not working in the hospitality industry at present.

The District Licensing Inspector did oppose the renewal due to a lack of evidence that employment has been gained or will be sought in the hospitality industry.

Leonie has worked at both on and off-licensed premises and there is no record of concerns with her past management of licensed premises.

Under section 218 of the Act the Committee must not renew a manager's certificate unless the manager holds the prescribed qualification.

As the applicant has successfully completed the Licence Controller Qualification Bridging Test, the committee is satisfied that the criteria as set out in s.224 of the Act has been met.

A renewal notice can and will be issued, subject to the applicant providing sufficient evidence to the Secretary, that appropriate employment has been gained in a licensed premises by or before 16 January 2020.
