DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Rebecca Charlotte Goodall for a Manager's Certificate.

The applicant holds a New Zealand work visa — Essential skills. Expiry Date 6 September 2022. She may only work as Assistant winemaker, sales and logistics manager in Canterbury for Salinity Imports Limited.

Rebecca is not currently involved in the retail sale of alcohol in New Zealand and she does expect this to change within the next few months.

In 2017 before holding a managers certificate, the applicant was involved in a failed CPO. She has since completed 'Servewise' and LCQ and her employers have given more emphasis to training staff.

In their reports, the Police did not oppose the application, however they did state concerns regarding the applicant not working in the hospitality industry at present.

The Licensing Committee has previously placed similar applications on hold for up to six months. During this time, it is expected that the applicant advised where they have gained employment as a duty manager.

Under section 218 of the Act the Committee must not renew a manager's certificate unless the manager holds the prescribed qualification.

As the applicant has successfully completed the Licence Controller Qualification, the committee is satisfied that the criteria as set out in s.224 of the Act has been met.

A renewal notice can and will be issued, subject to the applicant providing sufficient evidence to the Secretary, that appropriate employment has been gained in a licensed premises by or before **04 July 2020**.
