DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Chantelle Louise White for a Manager's Certificate.

In their report, the Police did not raise any matters in opposition to this application.

The Licensing Inspector inquired into the application and in her report dated 7 September 2020, concluded that:

"The Inspector considers the applicant does not have appropriate knowledge or skills at this time to be granted a manager's certificate. Having considered the application and supporting documentation, and made enquiries where appropriate, the Inspector requests the application be placed on hold for an appropriate period to enable the applicant to gain further experience and knowledge."

The Committee has evaluated the evidence and are not satisfied that the applicant meets the criteria as set out in s 222 of the Act at this time. The application will be placed on hold for a period of 6-months to enable the applicant to gain more industry experience and enable the completion of the Foodstuffs in-house LCQ training course.

The applicant will be re-assessed by the Licensing Inspector **after 25 March 2021**. The Committee will reevaluate the evidence and make a final decision on the application.
