DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Leigh Caren Wilson for a new Manager's Certificate.

In their report, the Police raised no matters in opposition to the application subject to the Inspector's satisfaction that the minimum required practical experience within the industry has been completed.

The District Licensing Inspector considers that the applicant's current work experience at the hotel and previous experience dealing with intoxicated patrons in her entertainment role has provided her with some of the relevant experience.

The criteria for which the District Licensing Committee must consider is set out in s.222 *Criteria for manager's certificates* of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The Committee has specific concerns regarding s.222 (c) of the Act:

"any experience, in particular recent experience, that the applicant has had in controlling any premises for which a licence was in force"

At this time, the Committee are unable to be satisfied that the applicant meets the criteria as set out in s.222 of the Act. The application will be **placed on hold** for a period of up to **three months**, being until **28th February 2022** to allow the applicant to gain experience in the industry as a duty manager.

At the end of this period the Inspector will complete further enquires into the matters set out in s.222 of the Act, and a further and final decision will be issued by the Committee.
