## **DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)**

This is an application by Leigh Caren Wilson for a Manager's Certificate.

The Police have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

In her report dated 23 November 2021, the Licensing Inspector raised concerns about the applicants relevant work experience at the hotel and previous experience dealing with intoxicated patrons in her entertainment role has provided her with some of the relevant experience. Accordingly, the Committee issued an initial decision no. 57/CERT/1697/2021, dated 29 November 2021 stating that:

"The application will be placed on hold for a period of up to three months, being until 28<sup>th</sup> February 2022 to allow the applicant to gain experience in the industry as a duty manager."

The Licensing Inspector met with the applicant on 7 March 2022 to discuss her practical experience over the previous three months. In her supplementary report, the Licensing Inspector stated that she is satisfied that the applicant now has sufficient practical experience to be issued a Manager's Certificate.

We are now satisfied that the applicant meets the criteria as set out in s.222 of the Act and grant the application accordingly.

The Manager's Certificate may issue immediately.
