DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Fancrest Estate Limited for renewal of an Off-Licence in respect of premises situated at 696 Omihiri Road, Omihiri, known as "Fancrest Estate".

No changes to the conditions of the licence have been sought by the applicant.

Fancrest Estate Limited trades as Fancrest Estate under an off-licence endorsed for remote sales of alcohol. Diane and Ian Holding are the company directors and shareholders, and they have held an off-licence since December 2009.

Diane is the only person who processes the orders and is the sole duty manager for the winery. She has also gained experience as the duty manager at the winery stall at Waipara/North Canterbury Wine and Food Festivals over several years. She has also been the duty manager at wine events in Auckland and Wellington during the past year.

The 2016 renewal application indicated an evacuation scheme was not required, however the 2019 renewal application indicated a scheme was held and maintained. This was queried with Fire and Emergency NZ (FENZ), based on the licensed area and the nature of the licence held. It was confirmed that an evacuation scheme is not required for this premises.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act. We renew the licence *on the existing terms and conditions* until **16 December 2022**, that being three years from the first anniversary of the licence.
