## **DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)**

This is an application by Michelle Beri and Lindsay Collins Partnership for renewal of an Off-Licence in respect of premises situated at 18 Lyndon Street, Waiau, known as "Waiau Lodge Hotel".

The applicant sought variation to the licensed area, to licence the tavern building rather than the existing hotel building which was damaged by the 2016 Earthquake. This variation is sought due to timeframes and costs associated with repairing the damaged hotel building.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act. We renew the licence until 20 May 2023, that being the anniversary date of the licence and three years from the most recent date of expiry.

As the Committee has granted the renewal of the on-licence with a variation to the licensed area, the Temporary Licence held for the tavern building under s.74 of the Act is no longer required and accordingly is cancelled.

Due to a practice direction from the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority we authorise the issue of a replacement licence with a new number and notice of renewal.
