## **DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)**

This is an application by MAKER2U Cellar Limited for renewal of an Off-Licence in respect of premises situated at 19 Mays Road, Leithfield, known as "MAKER2U Cellar Limited".

No changes to the conditions of the licence have been sought by the applicant.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

MAKER2U Cellar Limited was issued an off-licence (remote sales) on 17 April 2019, however due to website difficulties, trading did not commence until March 2020. The District Licensing Committee proposed a shortened renewal period of one-year to enable the licensee to demonstrate compliance with the licence conditions and alcohol legislation. In an email dated 8 June 2020, the licensee agreed to the Commitees proposal for a one-year renewal period.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act. We renew the licence on the existing terms and conditions until 17 April 2021, that being one year from the first anniversary of the licence.

Due to a practice direction from the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority we authorise the issue of a replacement licence with a new number and notice of renewal.
