DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Tongue In Groove Limited for an off-licence in respect of premises situated at 214 Mt Brown Road, Broomfield, known as Tongue In Groove.

The general nature of the business to be undertaken is that of remote sales. A remote sale can be made any time of the day. However, under s.59(1) of the Act delivery of alcohol made by remote sale is not permitted after 11.00pm on any day or before 6.00am on the next day.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 105 of the Act and we grant the applicant an off-licence authorising the remote sale and supply of alcohol, to any person for consumption off the premises.

The licence may issue immediately.

Requirements on holders of a 'remote sales' off-licence

The applicant's attention is drawn to s. 59 of the Act obliging the holder of a remote sales off-licence to:-

- Take reasonable steps to verify that the buyer of any alcohol that the holder sells by remote sale (and, if a person other than the buyer is to receive it, to verify that the receiver) is not under the purchase age.
- Take reasonable steps to verify that the buyer of any alcohol that the holder sells by remote sale is not under the purchase age if he or she complies with a procedure declared by regulations made under this Act to be a reasonable procedure for the purposes of complying with subsection .
- Must comply with any regulations made under this Act requiring information to be visible on the holder's website when people browse, enter, or otherwise access it.
