DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Nelson Hospitality Limited for renewal of an On-Licence in respect of premises situated at 10 Jacks Pass Road, Hanmer Springs, known as "Alpine Village Inn".

No changes to the conditions of the licence have been sought by the applicant.

Nelson Hospitality Limited has traded as Alpine Village Inn since 9 July 2018, firstly under a temporary authority for three months until the on and off-licences were issued on 1 November 2019.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application. FENZ initially opposed the application due to no trial evacuations taking place but this was confirmed as being removed on 28 November 2019.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act. We renew the licence on the existing terms and conditions until 01 November 2022, that being three years from the first anniversary of the licence.

Due to a practice direction from the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority we authorise the issue of a replacement licence with a new number and notice of renewal.
