DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by The Hogget Limited for renewal of on and off licences in respect of premises situated at 1 Gladstone Street, Hawarden, known as "The Hogget".

The Hogget Limited, trades as The Hogget, and has held licences for the tavern since January 2019.

The licensed areas for The Hogget were detailed on the floor plan of the premises attached to the applications.

The following on-licensed areas of the premises are designated as:

- The bar area containing the bar leaners – undesignated until 7pm then becomes supervised
- The restaurant and pool table areas - undesignated
- The outdoor lawn and paved areas – undesignated
- Concrete path – undesignated

The following off-licensed area of the premises is designated as:

- 1 metre in front of bar area - supervised

No changes to the conditions of the licences have been sought by the applicant.

The Hogget Limited employs three duty manager's at the premises.

The managers are:

- Sharryn Sillick has held a manager's certificate since 2016.
- Sue-Anne Gervais has been issued a manager's certificate in Christchurch
- Christina Mairs has held her manager's certificate since 2017.

The applicant has implemented positive steps in terms of Host Responsibility:

- The Host Responsibility Policy has been implemented.
- The food includes a range of bar snacks, lunch, children's menus, dinner and desserts.
- A range of hot and cold non-alcohol drinks are available. Heineken % is also available.
- The low alcohol options include Heineken Light, Speights Mid Ale and Hagen Citrus 2.5%.
- Free water is available from a self-service water station in the centre of the licensed area, and from the bar.
- A phone is available for patrons to make their own alternative transport arrangements.

The applicant also provides accommodation in cabins on the same property.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to these applications.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act and renew the licence until **25 January 2023** that being three years from the first anniversary of the licence.

Due to a practice direction from the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority we authorise the issue of a replacement licence with a new number and notice of renewal.
