DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Cartre 63 Holdings Limited for renewal of an On-Licence in respect of premises situated at 2 Highfield Street, Culverden, known as "The Red Post Cafe".

No changes to the conditions of the licence have been sought by the applicant.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application. The application was initially opposed by FENZ, however opposition was later withdrawn as an evacuation scheme is not required for the premises.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act. We renew the licence on the existing terms and conditions until the **2nd day of September 2024**, that being the anniversary date of the licence and three years from the most recent date of expiry.

Due to a practice direction from the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority we authorise the issue of a replacement licence with a new number and notice of renewal.
