DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Cheviot Rugby Football Club Incorporated for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 57 Ward Road, Cheviot and known as Cheviot Rugby Football Club

The nature of the particular event for which the licence is sought is a Private Farewell Party with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being **Saturday 15 June 2019 from 6.00pm to 1.00am the following day.** The bar will cease serving alcohol at 12.30am to allow a 'drink up' time.

The licensed area is supervised and includes the main clubroom hall, supper room, the outdoor veranda and the concrete area in front of the club to the fencing.

The special licence is for a private function for a farewell party for a local family. The applicant expects 150 people to attend, aged from 20 to 70 years of age.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event.

The licence may issue immediately.
