**DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)**

This is an application by Cheviot Golf Club Incorporated for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 71 Campbell Road, Cheviot and known as Cheviot Golf Club

The nature of the particular event for which the licence is sought is the Mid-Winter Dinner extra two hours until midnight with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Saturday 10 August 2019 from 10.00pm to 12.00 midnight.

The bar will cease serving alcohol at 11.30pm to allow a 'drink-up' time.

The licensed area is undesignated and includes the clubhouse and outside veranda.

The special licence is for the Cheviot Rugby Club's fundraising Mid-Winter Dinner. It is for club members and their partners with the special licence being required for two hours after the end of the club's licensed hours.

The applicant expects 60 people to attend the dinner. The people attending will be aged 35 to 75 years of age.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event.

The licence may issue immediately.
