DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Waiau Volunteer Fire Brigade for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 3 Cheviot Street, Waiau and known as Waiau Community Hall

The nature of the particular event for which the licence is sought is The Fire Brigade Honours Night with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Saturday 10 August 2019 from 5.00pm to 12.30 midnight. The bar will cease serving alcohol at 12.00 midnight to allow a 'drink up' time.

The licensed area is supervised and includes the interior of the Waiau hall.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

Section 208 allows for the Committee to waive certain omissions where they are satisfied that the neglect or omission was not wilful. In this situation the Committee agreed to accept the late application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event.

The licence may issue immediately.
