DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Robert Andrew Day & Gary James Mitchell for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 124 Cheviot Heights, Cheviot and known as Ribbonwood Country House

The nature of the particular series of occasions for which the licence is sought are Wine and cheese evenings as part of Hurunui Garden Festival with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Friday 01 and Saturday 02 November 2019 from 3.00pm to 5.30pm. Alcohol will not be served after 5.00pm to allow a 'drink up' time. The licensed area is undesignated and includes the formal dining and lounge areas of the house and the outdoor veranda seating areas.

Robert Day and Gary Mitchell are the proposed managers for the event and although they do not hold manager's certificates the Committee is satisfied that they will manage the conduct of the sale of alcohol in accordance with the licence. The licensees are exempt from the requirements of appointing a manager under subpart 7 of the Act.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event.

The licence may issue immediately.
