DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Hanmer Hospitality Limited for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 67 Jacks Pass Road, Hanmer Springs and known as Hanmer Springs Sports Grounds & Pavilion

The nature of the particular series of events for which the licence is sought are the Alpine Marathon and Mount Isobel Challenge with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Saturday 07 December 2019 from 10.00am to 4.00pm and Saturday 23 May 2020 from 10.00am to 4.00pm. The bar will cease serving alcohol 30 minutes prior to the end of the event to allow a 'drink up' time.

The licensed area is undesignated and includes the roped off area surrounding the various marquees including Food, Beverage and First aid.

Hanmer Hospitality Limited has held similar events each year since 2013/14 at the Hanmer Springs Domain. The special licence is for the sale of alcohol for consumption at two sporting events including running and mountain bike races:

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event.

The licence may issue immediately.
