DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Anthonie Ewen Tonnon for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 99 Princes Street, Waikari and known as Waikari War Memorial Hall

The nature of the particular event for which the licence is sought is Rail Land - Theatrical Music Show with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Saturday 14 December 2019 from 7.30pm to 10.00pm. The licensed area is undesignated and includes the interior of the hall.

Anthonie Ewen Tonnon has held these events in various New Zealand locations during 2018. A feature of the event is that Anthonie travels with the patrons on the rail transport to the event. He presents the production and therefore employs a local duty manager for the events.

Margaret Rayner (Maggie) is the proposed manager for this event. She holds a current manager's certificate and has previously managed similar events held by the Hurunui Theatre Group.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event.

The licence may issue immediately.
