## **DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)**

This is an application by Georges Road Vineyard Partnership for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 651 Mt Brown Road, Broomfield and known as Georges Road Wines

The nature of the particular event for which the licence is sought is a work Christmas Party with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Tuesday 17 December 2019 from 12.00 midday to 4.00pm. The bar will cease serving alcohol 30 minutes prior to the end of the event to allow a 'drink up' time.

The licensed area is undesignated and includes the tasting room, barrel room, outdoor concrete area and adjacent grassed area.

Georges Road Vineyard has operated a tasting room by appointment only since September 2016. The applicant has held a previous special licence for an event at the winery and for several years at the North Canterbury Wine and Food Festival.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event.

The licence may issue immediately.
