DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Glenmark Rugby Football Club for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 11 Reeces Road, Omihi and known as Glenmark Rugby Club

The nature of the particular series of events for which the licence is sought is Glenmark Rugby Centennial with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Friday 03 April 2020 from 6.00pm to 1.00am the following day and Saturday 04 April 2020 3.00pm to 1.00am the following day. **The bar will close at 12.30am each day to allow for a 30-minute drink-up time.**

The licensed areas are designated as “supervised” and include:

- The main hall and meeting room of the Omihi Community Hall, and
- The exterior north and west paved and grassed areas adjacent to the hall, and
- A marquee located in the car park.

The Glenmark Rugby Football Club has held a club-licence since 1994 and has previously held special licences for functions at the clubrooms.

Sally Berry is the proposed duty manager for the event. Sally is the sole director, shareholder and duty manager for Bain Road Wines Limited, which holds an off-licence for a cellar door to enable tasting events at the winery site and the sale of bottles of wine from the premises.

The Greta Valley Fire Brigade members will operate the bar, and have previous experience doing this at events for the rugby club.

The duty manager, will brief all event staff on their roles and responsibilities and the conditions of the licence.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event.

The licence may issue immediately.
